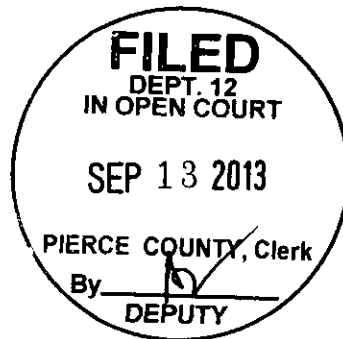

**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING, A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND A SHOW CAUSE ORDER AGAINST HUNTER DONALDSON AND MULTICARE**

**THIS MATTER** having come before the Court upon Plaintiff's Motion for a Temporary Restraining, a Preliminary Injunction and a Show Cause Order Against Hunter Donaldson and MultiCare, filed September 5, 2013, and the Court having considered the following:

ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING, A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND A SHOW CAUSE ORDER AGAINST HUNTER DONALDSON AND MULTICARE



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1. Plaintiff's Motion for a Temporary Restraining, a Preliminary Injunction and a Show Cause Order Against Hunter Donaldson and MultiCare, including all declarations, exhibits and materials submitted in support thereof;
2. Defendants' Opposition briefing, including all declarations, exhibits, and materials submitted in support thereof;
3. Plaintiff's Reply briefing, including all declarations, exhibits, and materials submitted in support thereof;
4. The Complaint for Damages and the attachments therewith; and
5. The parties' oral argument;

And the Court deeming itself fully advised, **FINDS** that Plaintiff Christina Miesmer ("Miesmer") has demonstrated that she has a reasonable likelihood of succeeding on the merits of her case at trial with respect to the notary and signature on the lien and her legal remedies are inadequate.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that Plaintiff's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order, a Preliminary Injunction and a Show Cause Order Against Defendants Hunter Donaldson and MultiCare is **GRANTED** as follows:

It is **ORDERED** the parties are directed as follows:

1. Hunter Donaldson and Plaintiff Christina Miesmer shall both endorse the check for the amount of \$10,445.35, issued by Progressive, payable to Christina Miesmer and Hunter Donaldson, check draft number 478545967, payable through PNC Bank, N.A., Ashland, Ohio;
2. The proceeds of the said check shall be turned over in full to Plaintiff Christina Miesmer;

- 3. Plaintiff Christina Miesmer shall then deposit from these proceeds the amount of \$6,250 into the Registry of the Court; and
- 4. The \$6,250 shall remain in the Registry of the Court pending further order by the Court.

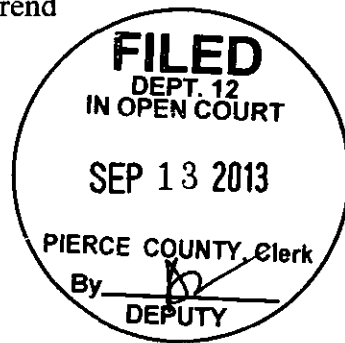
